Name of Assignment: Consultancy services for detailed design for the rehabilitation of both Pequenos Libombos and Massingir dams, and supervision of the works for Pequenos Libombos dam

1. The Government of Mozambique (GoM) received financing from the World Bank (WB) toward the cost of the Regional Climate Resilience Program for Eastern & Southern Africa (RCRP/E&SA). The RCRP aims to increase the resilience of vulnerable populations against climate shocks such as cyclones, floods and droughts. Therefore, the GoM through the National Directorate of Water Resource and Management (DNGRH) with the support of the WB, intends to hire a Consultancy service for detailed design for the rehabilitation of both Pequenos Libombos and Massingir dams, and supervision of the works for Pequenos Libombos dam.
2. The consulting services include to assist National Directorate of Water Resources Management for:
 - a. Review and finalize the investigation plan and specifications for additional investigations (hydrology, topography and geology) existing;
 - b. Prepare Detailed Design and Tender Documents for the rehabilitation/upgrading of Massingir and Pequenos Libombos Dam, in accordance with the appropriate version of the World Bank Guidelines and Standard Bidding Documents for the Prequalification process and Procurement of works.
 - c. Prepare the Dam Safety Management Plan (DSMP), Rehabilitation Supervision and Quality Assurance Plan (CSQAP), the dam instrumentation plan (IP), the Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Plan, and the Emergency Preparedness Plan (EPP) in compliance with the Environmental and Social Standard (ESS) 4-Annex 1 on dam safety and following recommendations of WB's Good practice note on dam safety (GPN)¹;
 - d. Carry out supervision and quality assurance for the rehabilitation/upgrading works of Pequenos Libombos dam

3. The detailed Terms of Reference for the assignment can be found at the bellow address. The DNGRH, the implementing agency, now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consulting Firms should provide information, indicating that they have the required qualification and relevant experience to perform the services. The information to be provided shall include company profile with financial information, description of successful accomplishment of similar assignment with equivalent size and complexity. The shortlisting criteria are:
- General experience of the firm: Preferably 15 years’ experience having undertaken a similar assignment.
 - Experience in design and/or work supervision of large dams higher the 40 meters;
 - At least 3 contracts completed or in progress for design and/or work supervision of dams for more than US\$2 million each in the last 5 years.
 - The consultant firm should be fully conversant with application of the ICOLD guidelines and the WB’s Good Practice Note on Dam Safety.

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage

4. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” September 2023 (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
5. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
6. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
